## Disciplinary Procedures

Conduct or behaviour offences which take place during games are usually referred to a Basketball Victoria tribunal by a referee or other association official. Incidents may occur which involve a Woodend Hawks Coach, Team Manager, Player, Parent or Spectator breaching the Basketball Victoria Codes of Conduct or the Woodend Hawks Basketball Club Rules, or behaving in a way that causes damage or harm to the Club. If Basketball Victoria tribunal proceedings are not instituted for such an incident, the Woodend Hawks Basketball Club Committee will institute the following disciplinary procedure:

**First offences** (other than serious breaches of the BV Codes of Conduct) – the incident will be reported to the Committee for investigation, and if warranted, a written warning will be issued.

**Second and subsequent offences, and/or serious breaches of the BV Codes of Conduct** – the incident will be reported to the Committee for investigation. If warranted, a disciplinary meeting will be convened with the relevant Coach, Team Manager, Player, Parent or Spectator, Member/s of the Committee and an independent decisionmaker. All parties will be given the opportunity to be heard.

The independent decisionmaker will determine the appropriate sanction which may include further warnings, meetings, suspension and/or expulsion of a player, removal from the role of a Coach or Team Manager, or a ban on Spectator attendance at training or games.

Any disciplinary procedures instituted by the Woodend Hawks Basketball Club will be completed as soon as reasonably practicable.
